## Barracuda SPAM Filter

**JA utilizes a SPAM filter for all inbound email from the outside to @MVLS and @SALS addresses. The filter is a solution from Barracuda Networks, one of the top-rated SPAM filters in the industry.**

The Barracuda analyzes thousands of emails a day to help prevent SPAM and Phishing.

Every day at 3:35 PM you will receive an email from [no-reply@sals.edu](mailto:no-reply@sals.edu) if you have any quarantined items for that day. Additionally, you can go to <https://cuda.sals.edu> at any time to check for quarantined messages. Login using your email address and password (same as your Polaris login credentials).

<https://cuda.sals.edu> also allows you to add email addresses to your allowed or block lists. This is done from the preferences tab (see additional documentation link for details).

Sometimes SPAM filters block legitimate emails. If you are expecting an email that has not arrived, always check your quarantine via <https://cuda.sals.edu>. Then please contact computer support if you are still unable to locate the message(s).
